



Pomona Valley Memorial Park

Pomona Valley Memorial Park is an Endowment Care Memorial Property which provides graves for ground burial, a Crematorium, Mausoleum and a Columbarium. The site is a beautiful setting with numerous old shade trees.

The park is older than the city of Pomona. The first interment was in 1876. In 1882 the park was organized and incorporated as the Pomona Cemetery Association by the Odd Fellows. Ten years later it was reorganized into the nonprofit corporation that exists today. Managed by a board of directors composed of people from the community it serves.
